MRHD to Announce 2023 Economic Development Match Grant Award

The MRHD Economic Development Match Grant is a competitive grant opportunity that provides up to \$1 million and is designed to bring other funders together, and to support economic development projects within Woodbury County that need potentially higher levels of funding and collaboration. The grant must be matched dollar-for-dollar with cash or in-kind contributions, and the project must be completed within two years.
